







REQUIRED 8th GRADE ORCHESTRA SUPPLIES: VIOLIN

Please check off the box in the lower right corner of each item you acquire them. All items must be in class no later than Monday, August 13.

<p>VIOLIN AND BOW</p>  <input data-bbox="575 542 625 581" type="checkbox"/> <p>8th graders need Prelude brand strings or better, such as Tonica, Pro Arte, Dominant etc.</p>	<p>-Violins are expected to rent an instrument for their use. Instruments are expected to come to school AND go home every single school day.</p> <p>-RENT TO OWN: Reputable string stores offer in house repair, upgrades and trade-in policies. Your child will grow and need to exchange for bigger sizes. Renting provides this service free of charge.</p> <p>-AVOID THE INTERNET: Please avoid purchasing violins on popular internet sites. Going to a reputable dealer and renting an instrument is a much safer idea for your hard earned money. A cheaper, poor quality instrument “outfit” will inhibit your child’s progress.</p>	<p>HABITS OF A SUCCESSFUL MIDDLE LEVEL STRING MUSICIAN</p>  <input data-bbox="1593 602 1644 641" type="checkbox"/>	<p>-All students must purchase the HABITS OF A SUCCESSFUL MIDDLE LEVEL STRING MUSICIAN method book from a music store or online as soon as possible.</p> <p>-Make sure it says VIOLIN at the top.</p> <p>-If you would like to purchase through the school, please send in \$10 in school envelope labeled ”method book”</p>	
<p>SHOULDER REST & MUSIC STAND</p>  <input data-bbox="575 899 625 938" type="checkbox"/>	<p>-All violinists must own a genuine shoulder rest and label it with their name. Brands like Kun and Everest tend to hold up the best to wear & tear.</p> <p>-NO SPONGES ALLOWED.</p> <p>-All violinists need their own music stand for at home practice and for concerts.</p>	<p>CLASSROOM WISH LIST:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • COPY PAPER (ANY COLOR) • HAND SANITIZER • TISSUES • BAND-AIDS <p>Anything you can/are willing to donate from this list would be most appreciated and put to good use in our classroom! 😊😊😊</p>	<p>ROSIN</p>  <input data-bbox="1593 899 1644 938" type="checkbox"/>	<p>-All violinists must own their own rosin and label it with their name. Brands like Hill and Pirastro make excellent rosin, but most rentals come with their own rosin.</p> <p>-Light or Dark colored rosin is acceptable.</p>
<p>ORCHESTRA & CHORUS UNIFORM Order form is located on Daniellorchestra.org</p>  <input data-bbox="575 1273 625 1312" type="checkbox"/>	<p>-Chorus & Orchestra use the same uniform so you only need to purchase <u>one</u> uniform if you are also in chorus.</p> <p>-All students must purchase the concert uniform if not already owned.</p> <p>-\$60 must be placed in a school envelope from our classroom and then placed into the black box in the hallway.</p>		<p>CLEANING CLOTH & PENCIL INSIDE CASE</p>  <input data-bbox="1593 1273 1644 1312" type="checkbox"/>	<p>-All violinists must wipe off their rosin with a cloth from their strings and instrument after use to keep instrument in good condition. Any soft cloth or T-shirt material will do.</p> <p>-All violinists must keep pencils in their case at all times to mark their music and take notes during class. No pens allowed.</p>
