NOTES PARTS


Notes have separate parts which tell us how long or short they are. Each of these parts has a name. It is important to memorize the name of each note part.

Stems on notes *may go either up or down* depending on where the note is placed on the staff.

Stems go **up on** the **right** of the note body and **down on** the **left** of the note body.

- 1. Look carefully at the notes drawn below.
- 2. Notice each part is labeled with a name by the arrow.
- 3. Try to memorize the name of each part.
- 4. By the arrows with a blank line, write the correct name for each note part.
