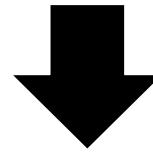
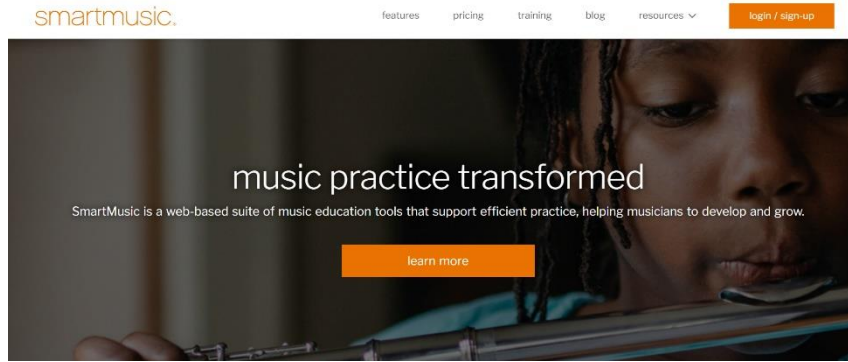

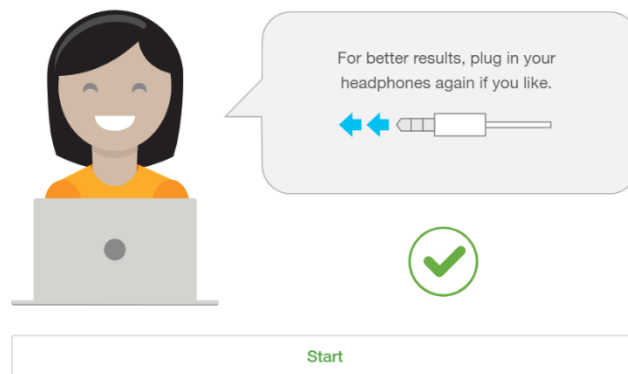

Instructions for your assignment

General Instructions:

Use these first few book lines as rhythm practice. I know it will feel easy to some of you, but it's important to review what we learned last year to build upon it and expand our knowledge.

Part Instructions:

Pizzicato both the teacher and student parts. Make sure to score 100% before moving on. If you are not scoring 100% but you know that your rhythm is correct, you need to tune. Smart music will count off for intonation, unsteady rhythm and wrong notes.
