

HOW TO SIGN UP FOR SMART+ MUSIC

1. Go to smartmusic.com
2. Click “create account”
3. Fill out your info
 - a. You need to click that you are 13, even if you are not yet, in order to make the account.
 - b. You need to use an email address of your own that you can check to approve the account afterwards.
 - c. You do not need a second email address.
 - d. Your username can be whatever you want that is school appropriate, but I recommend using your email to log in instead anyway.
 - e. Use your lunch number as the password so you don't forget it.
 - f. Choose your instrument. If you're bass, choose “contrabass”
4. Go to your email and confirm the address.
5. Go back to the main page and log in using the email or username and password you just created.
6. At the top, click on the circle with a person inside.
7. Click “join a class”
8. Enter the code for your class:

8th Grade : AJANH-4AVVE

4th Period 7th Grade: VELJC-4RHCF

Fifth Period 7th Grade : 7YWR7-VAPJE

6th Grade: QGVFZ-DH2EH

9. Click “view all” above the assignments box
10. Click “start” on the first assignment. GO IN ORDER.
11. Click “Complete assignment”
12. Complete the microphone test
13. Read any instructions that pop up
14. Begin practicing the music first!
 - a. Do not submit your first take if it isn't 100%. Practice and submit once you're sure you've scored as high as you can. Take your time.
 - b. Your score appears after recording with a check mark beside it.
15. Click SUBMIT when done. Do not click save, as this will only save it to your computer, not submit it.
16. Have a question about the assignment? You can type it in the box before submitting but remember to keep comments polite and academic.

FAQ

My email isn't working!

Check the spelling. Do not try to use the email in my example video...you have to use your own email.

My password isn't working!

Reset it using the email address that you entered. If that doesn't work, ask mrs. newton to reset it.

You reset my password...what is it now?

It will be food2021 until you reset it to something yourself.

What do the colored notes mean?

Red = out of tune yellow = too fast or too slow green= correct

Why does it keep saying I'm wrong when I know that I'm right?

You're probably out of tune. Use the tuner at the top of the page and check your open strings. Adjust carefully and only small amounts at a time to get in tune.

I've tried everything but I just can't score higher...what should I do?

Submit it anyway so that I can listen to it. Add a comment listing what's happening and I'll either edit the grade (if it's a technology issue) or reassign it with specific instructions.

I submitted an assignment but it reappeared. What do I do?

Is it a 60 in studentvue? If it is, I reassigned it with instructions on how to redo what wasn't correct.

I have a zero but I did the assignment!

Email me directly and politely let me know. I'll fix it.

I have a zero and I didn't do the assignment!

Get it done asap and email to let me know it's finished. Next time, complete it by the deadline.
